1 Check Eligibility Conditions

To submit an application under the Greater Montreal Climate Fund's call for projects, you must ensure you are eligible. You may apply if you are:

- √ A municipality
- ✓ A public enterprise
- ✓ A registered charity
- \checkmark A nonprofit organization or an individual affiliated with one
- ✓ An educational institution or a school board, including an individual school, a classroom, or a university.
